



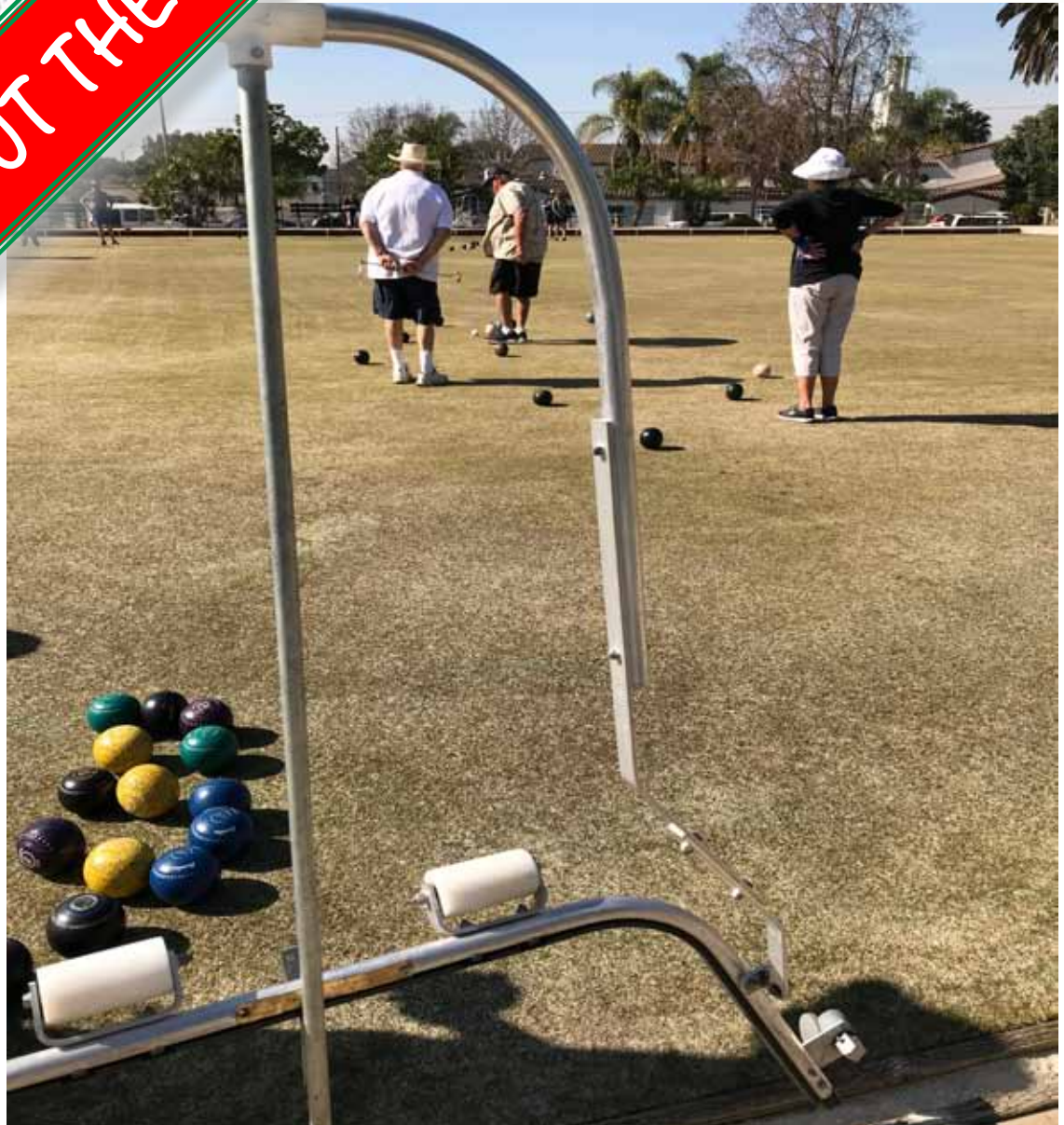

I want to thank Jackie Huisman (a Club ex-president) for keeping us informed with her emails and the website.



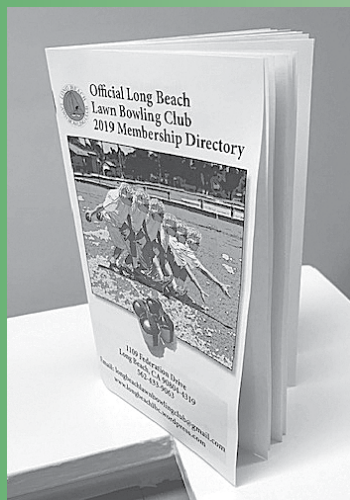
## *Also...*

They produce a quality magazine as well as the electronic media, and have been in business for over five years now.

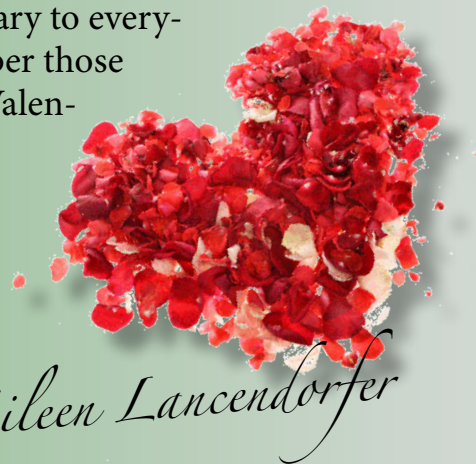
Our Club can not afford to advertise in the magazine but we were able to get funded for a years-worth of four articles in the electronic media. The app is free, all you have to do is down load it.

# What You Should Know...

This Is All About The 908 App...

**What do you do after you download the FREE 908 app?**

Hi. I have taken on the task for working with the 908 app people.

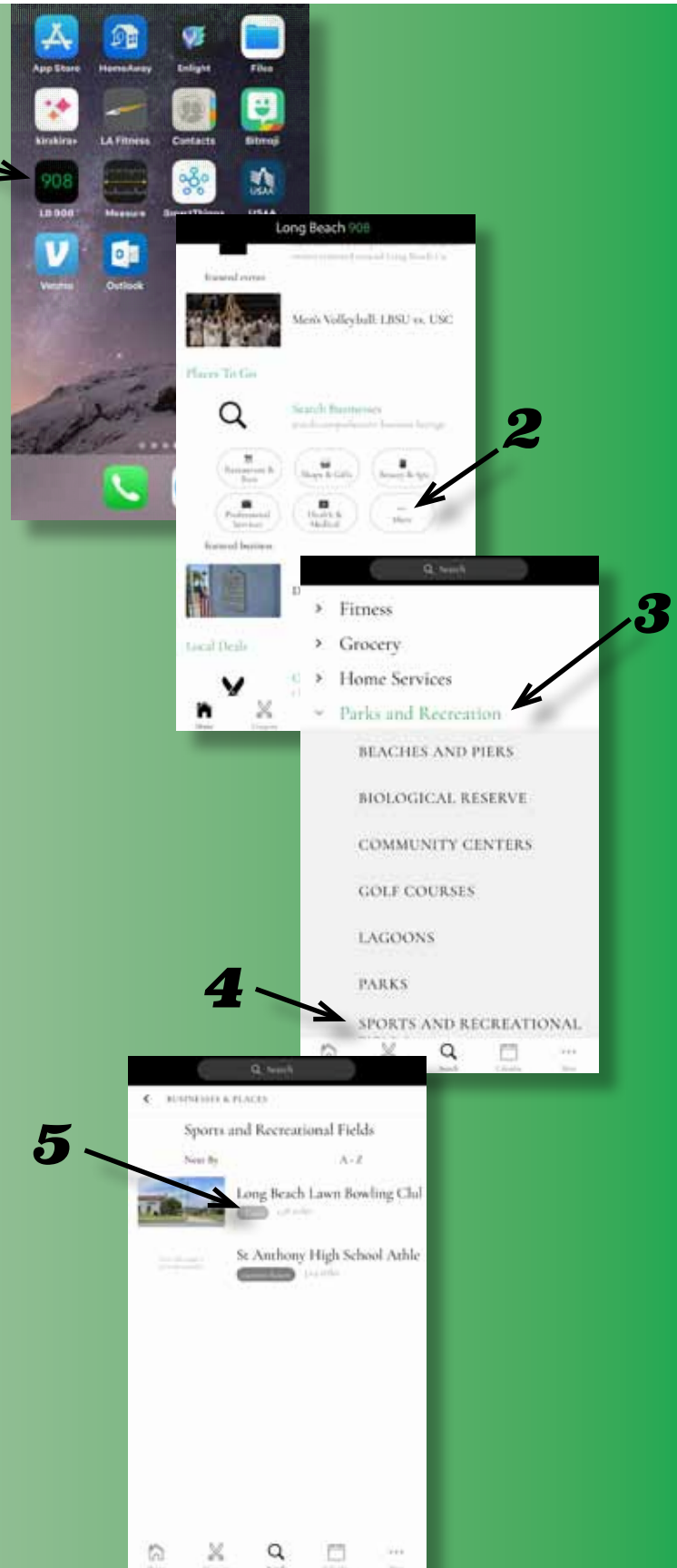
I'm familiar with downloading app's on my computer and iPhone, but I was "lost" when it came to navigating the 908 app at first. After some trial and error (and conversations with John Grossi, the owner) I now know what to do and would like to share with you what I have learned.

**Step by step...**

- Step 1 – Click on the app symbol to get started which takes you to the "home page".
- Step 2 – Click on the *more* button.
- Step 3 – Scroll down to *Parks and Recreation*
- Step 4 – Click on *Parks and Recreation* and scroll down to *SPORTS AND RECREATION-AL FIELDS* and click on it
- Step 5 – Click on *Long Beach Lawn Bowling Club*
- Step 6 – Click on "about", the basic article written by the 908 staff. (Note the link to our website)
- Step 7 – Click on "articles & videos"
- Step 8 – Click on "A Beginner's Guide to Lawn Bowling" for the full article promoting FREE lessons.

As the app is updated with our future articles, you will be able to see the titles. Just click on the titled subject you are interested in reading.

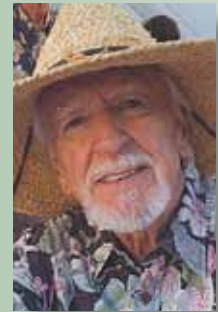
# More On What You Should Know...
