“I would like all members – Leads, Vices and Skips – to get out your little book

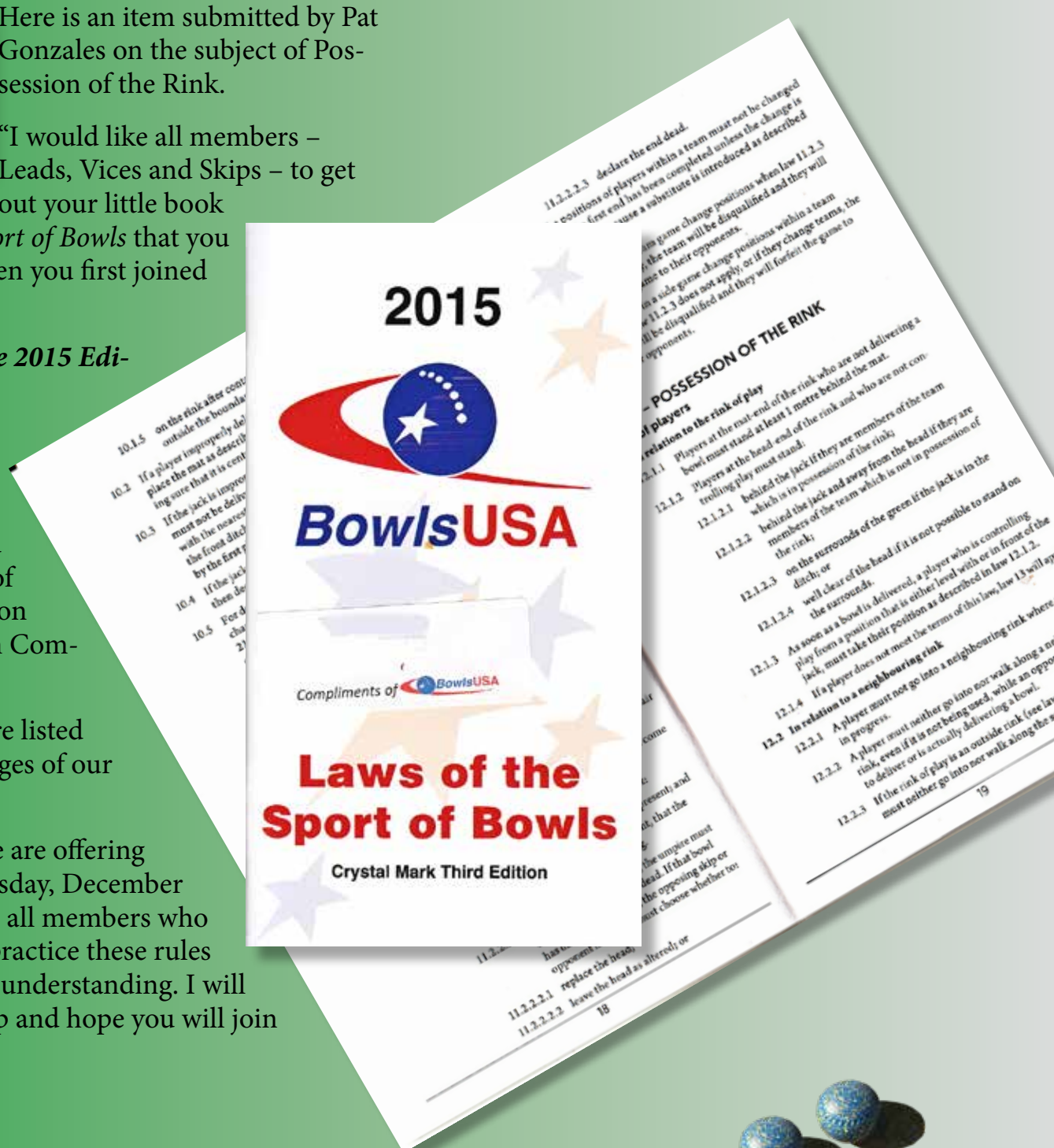
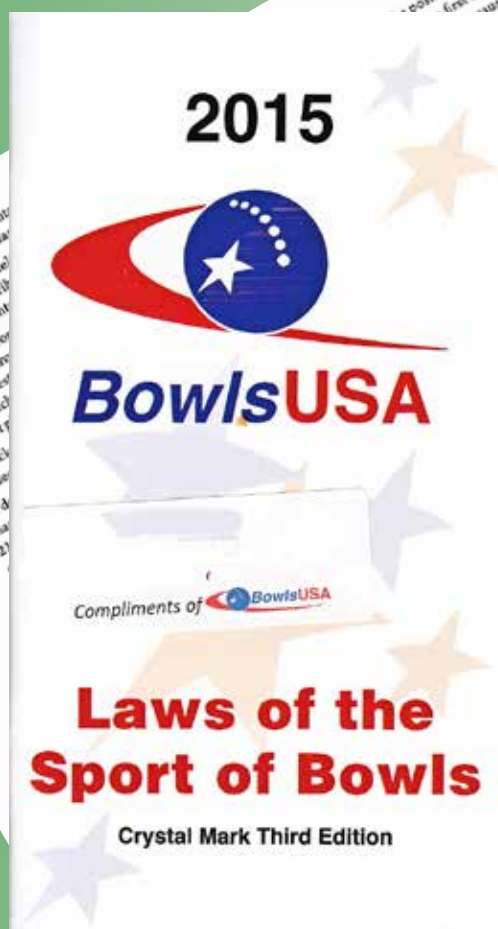
Laws of the Sport of Bowls that you were given when you first joined the club.
